Death Certificates are processed by our staff with the vital statistical information given by the family. The doctor or the medical examiner will sign this certificate. Next, the Health Department in the county which the death occurred will generate the Certified Death Certificate. Death certificates are issued by county of death. The charge for each certificate is determined by this county, ranging from \$5.00 to \$12.00 per copy. If you need additional death certificates, these may be obtained at the health department in the county in which the death occurred. Listed below are the two different types of death certificates that can be obtained from the health department.
